Rugby, Ball, Light.

Be sure to read, understand and follow these instructions and warnings before using this light.

Instructions (replacing or changing the bulb):

- 1. Unplug the lamp from the electrical supply.
- 2. Standard Rugby Ball Light

Whilst firmly holding the 'kickers tee' base, twist the ball envelope anti-clockwise to remove it. It may be helpful to have someone assist with this. Crystal Rugby Ball Light

Firmly holding the glass 'ball' lift is straight up and clear of the installed bulb.

- 3. Install a recommended lamp by snugly screwing the lamp in place.
- 4. Replace the twist lock ball envelope
- 5. Plug into a suitable electrical socket.

Warning:

- To avoid risk of suffocation keep all packaging away from children.
- Do NOT use standard filament lamps.
- E27 (ES) 26w (max.) energy saving lamp. Compact Fluorescent (CFL) or LED bulb ONLY.
- No user serviceable parts.
- This product is not adapted for use in play by children under 14 years old.
- Dispose of packaging responsibly and recycle where possible.

We want you to be able to enjoy your Rugby Ball Light wherever you decide to use it. Different uses require different bulb types. We do not include a bulb with the light, so that you can choose the perfect bulb for your needs.
